



PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Players are the most important people in the sport. Playing for your team is an essential part of the game. Fair play and respect for others in the game will make the sport more fun and enjoyable for everyone.

Players should:

- Try their hardest.
- Set a good example, especially to younger players and supporters.
- Know and obey the laws of the game.
- Play fairly and shake hands after every game.
- Try to accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.
- Treat opponents with respect at all times, irrespective of the result of the game.
- Help injured opponents.
- Show respect towards Match Officials.
- Accept the decision of the Match Officials without protest.
- Show respect towards the coaches, helpers, club officials and supporters.
- Listen and obey the coaches.

Players should never:

- Use inappropriate or offensive language.
- Physically or verbally abuse other players in their own team or in other teams.
- Lie to Match Officials.
- Cheat, waste time or behave in an unsportsmanlike manner.
